Ireland service

With seven weekly sailings from Rotterdam to Dublin, Cork, Waterford, Belfast and vice versa, Samskip offers frequent and reliable shortsea services to the north, middle and south of Ireland. Road transport distances for collection and delivery can be kept to a minimum, allowing fast and cost effective transport solutions. Multimodal into Germany, Italy and Eastern Europe
 Into Germany Samskip offers train connections to Mannheim, Munich and Ludwigshafen as well as frequent barge sailings to/from Duisburg. Italy is served through daily rail shuttles connecting the hubs in Novara, Verona, Pomezia, Bari, Bologna, and Padova. Samskip also offers frequent rail services to Poland, Czech Republic, Hungary and Slovakia; e.g., connecting Poznan, Kutno, Praha, Plzen, Dunajska, and Budapest.

Wide range of equipment

Samskip's main emphasis lies with the 45ft pallet wide container, which is also available in a high cube version. In addition, Samskip offers curtain sided containers and reefers. Flat rack equipment is offered to transport out of gauge cargo. This equipment has top, side and end loading capabilities and is ideal to transport all kinds of over-length, over-width and over-height cargo, such as wood and cranes.

Part loads from Italy

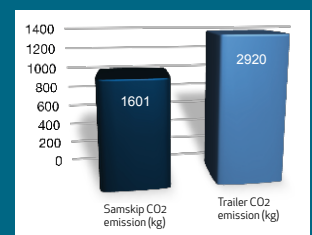
Apart from full container loads, Samskip now also offers part loads (LCL) on the Italy-Ireland corridor. Combining the Milano-Rotterdam rail service and two-weekly Rotterdam-Dublin sailings, on Tuesdays and Fridays, Samskip enables fast deliveries for a competitive price while saving on CO2 emissions.

Sustainable transport solution

The environmental advantages of multimodal transport solutions are striking on the Ireland route. The example on the right shows that the CO2 emission when transporting cargo from Flumeri (IT) to Dublin (IE) can be reduced by just over 1300 kg when using a multimodal transport solution.
